Greetings from Camp Mennoscah!

We're so glad you're interested in being part of our summer youth camp program! The summer staff positions are: crafts leader, music leader, lifeguard, assistant lifeguard/maintenance, naturalist, office assistant, and grounds/maintenance. Volunteer positions for counseling, kitchen staff, and maintenance/custodial are also available on a weekly or summer-long basis.

Summer staff qualifications include the following: agreement with the Camp Mennoscah mission statement, ability to relate well with campers and staff of all ages, capable of making sound decisions, a strong work ethic, flexible and calm in emergencies, and the ability to have fun. Summer staff must be 18 years old or older, preferably with at least one completed year of college or work/volunteering.

Our 2012 summer camp season runs from June 4 to August 8. Actual summer camps begin June 10. Summer staff is expected to be available for all weeks/days unless advance arrangements are made. There is often one week during the summer where reduced staff is needed. Staff will be scheduled according to programming needs. Weekend hours are rotated among staff.

The summer staff salary is \$200 per camp week. Orientation, all extra work days, and work days following the end of summer youth camps are prorated based on time worked. Summer youth camp weeks are \$200 per week, even if the week is a short week. The week with a PreJunior camp and First Camp is considered one week. If staff leave early or make arrangements to be gone for any stretch of time during a camp week, their weekly salary may be prorated.

Summer staff must have their own health/medical insurance. Room and board is provided. Summer staff is responsible for having and maintaining all certifications as required for their position.

We welcome you to fill out the application form and background check consent form, sign them, and send them back to us in the mail. Your application will then be reviewed by Camp Mennoscah staff. An interview may be requested. It may be several weeks after we receive your application before the application process is completed. Hiring decisions will begin February 9, but applications will be accepted until all positions are filled. Positions are expected to be announced by March 15. We suggest application forms be turned in as soon as possible for the best opportunities.
