Seminary Scholarship Guidelines

The Need: The purpose of the seminary scholarships is to assist persons attending seminary. The funds for these scholarships are made available by Western District Conference, Mennonite Men of the Plains, and Western District Mennonite Women.

Who qualifies for Scholarships: Scholarships shall be available to persons attending seminary for credit (1) who are members of a Western District Conference church or were baptized in a Western District Conference congregation; (2) who are enrolled in a pastoral ministry degree program in an MCUSA related institution. Exceptions may be made by the Leadership Commission.

Scholarship amount: The amount of the scholarships will be determined by the Leadership Commission on the basis of funds available and number of applications.

How to apply: Application is to be made using the prepared application form. Approval of scholarships will be given by the Western District Conference Leadership Commission. Applications should be submitted to the Conference office, PO Box 306, North Newton, KS 67117 or wdc@mennowdc.org, 15 days prior to the beginning of the semester.
