

How does it work?

We are offering you HOURS of uninterrupted cropping time. Each person will be assigned individual table space in the Retreat Center.

The recommended age for scrapbookers is 3rd grade and above. There are no separate children's programs or child care provisions. Special arrangements will be made for nursing mothers of infants.

Four Workshop offerings are scheduled throughout the weekend which you may attend voluntarily.

Six meals are provided: Friday supper, Saturday breakfast, lunch and supper, and Sunday breakfast and lunch.

In an attempt to keep expenses at a minimum, all attendees are responsible for cleaning up their own space and assigned room.
