\$461,550 is needed from WDC Churches in 2018


The pie chart illustrates that contributions from churches and individuals are the vast majority of WDC's income. When we receive the same amount of contributions from churches every year as our costs continue to rise, we will be forced to make more cuts to our

programs and staff. We commend those congregations who have increased their giving to WDC. This mutual aid guarantees that we can provide services to all our congregations and we all benefit from these connections.


The 2018 spending plan will need a 5% increase in giving from churches and individuals to fund our planned ministries.
