Knudsen Monroe & Company, LLC Certified Public Accountants have completed an audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards and produced a series of financial statements that in all material respects represent fairly the financial position of the Western District Conference as of January 31, 2012. The WDC will make this report available to members upon request.

The Western District Conference of Mennonite Church USA recorded its financial activity with the use of five separate funds:

General Fund. This fund records the transactions of the principal ministries of the Conference. It is into this fund that individual, organizational and congregational contributions go to pay for conference's expenses. Members contributed \$414,789 to the General Fund in 2011/12. At the end of the year 10% of the Bequest Fund (\$49,772) was added to the general fund.

Revolving Loan Fund. This fund operates separately, is governed by the Trustees Task Force and is used primarily to finance church buildings for member congregations and for capital improvements on Conference property.

2500 Place Fund. This fund also operates separately from the General Fund and records transactions related to the office and retail building owned by the conference. Rental income from tenants enables the conference to occupy its offices with no charge to the General Fund.

Camp Fund. This fund records the operations of Camp Mennoscah.

General Plant Fund. This fund records all physical assets such as buildings, equipment and land. In 2011/12 the General Plant Fund was decreased \$29,681 in depreciation and increased \$22,430 by capital improvements. This brings the net assets of the General Plant Fund at the end of the year 2011/12 to \$197,763

General Fund Restricted Accounts

- Bequest Fund receives undesignated estate gifts of \$500 or more. In 2011 10% or \$49,772 was transferred to the annual budget. \$5,539 was earned in interest and -\$6,937 was lost through market adjustments on the Mennonite Foundation account. Bequests in the amount of \$11,906 were added to the fund from the estates of Verna Waltner, Philip and Frances Johnson and Martha Stucky.
- Vision 2012 Fund receives contributions for the Vision 2012 campaign drive. In 2011 WDC members contributed \$238,298 toward the campaign and \$2,693 was earned in interest on CDs and market adjustments on the Mennonite Foundation account. \$261,962 was spent for Vision 2012 projects which includes the camp swimming pool.
- Koontz Memorial Fund for the continuing education needs of WDC pastors earned \$1,086 in interest on CDs and market adjustments on the Mennonite Foundation account. The fund made 21 grants totaling \$3,874.
- Doris Goertz Scholarship Fund for individuals with particular needs who are preparing for or serving in a Christian vocation earned \$206 in interest. No grants were awarded.
- Centennial Fund Drive/Encouragement Grants assist mission churches in obtaining a meeting place or to meet short term needs. The fund earned \$4 in interest and made 1 grant of \$325 to Linda Berry, Metro Mennonite congregation, for AMBS classes.
- Centennial Fund Drive/Congregational Development Fund defrays the cost of employing consultants in congregations. This fund earned \$1,501 in interest and \$640 in repayments. The fund made 3 grants to congregations totaling \$1,081.
- The Annuity Gift Program began the year with two participants and ended the year with two.
- Western District Women in Mission Scholarship Fund provides seminary scholarships for women from the Western District. In 2011 this fund earned \$883 in interest and the Western District Women in Mission contributed \$1,213 to the fund. Scholarships were awarded to Jocelyn Graber for her work at AMBS-Great Plains in the fall and spring.
- Other restricted accounts result from retreats, workshops, scholarship funds and grants. Commissions that govern the various accounts detail the activities of these accounts in reports.
