The Trustees Task Force was formed to review loan applications for the Revolving Loan Fund, make recommendations as to the acceptance of property or disposal of property, evaluate and enter into legal contracts (real property) and to supervise and manage Conference property.

Revolving Fund

As of January 31, 2020, the Revolving Loan Fund had three loans receivable totaling \$141,666.25.

2500 Place Building

During 2019 the 2500 Place Building in North Newton had 5 tenants for the full year and an additional tenant September – January, all spaces were occupied.

In 2019, a couple major repairs were needed including replacing another air conditioning unit and fixing a water leak that required tearing up a section of the parking lot. Renting out the portion of the building not needed for Western District covers the cost of routine maintenance and other routine building expenses, however does not cover major expenses such as those incurred in 2018 & 2019. 2500 Place Building fund received a loan from the Revolving Fund to cover these expenses in 2018, and this helped cover the 2019 expenses as well. Loan repayment is included in the 2020 and proposed 2021 Western District budgets.
