Knudsen Monroe & Company, LLC Certified Public Accountants have completed an audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards and produced a series of financial statements that in all material respects represent fairly the financial position of the Western District Conference as of January 31, 2020. Western District Conference (WDC) will make this report available to members upon request.

The Western District Conference of Mennonite Church USA recorded its financial activity with the use of four separate funds:

General Fund. This fund records the transactions of the principal ministries of the Conference. It is into this fund that individual, organizational and congregational contributions go to pay for conference's expenses. Members contributed \$353,908 to the General Fund in 2019/20. At the end of the year, Executive Board approved for \$80,419 (12.5744%) of the Bequest Fund be moved to the general fund. This is \$16,645 above the 10% that is automatically transferred each year.

Revolving Loan Fund. This fund operates separately, is governed by the Trustees Task Force and is used primarily to finance church buildings for member congregations and for capital improvements on Conference property.

2500 Place Fund. This fund also operates separately from the General Fund and records transactions related to the office and retail building owned by the conference. Rental income from tenants enables the conference to occupy its offices with no charge to the General Fund.

General Plant Fund. This fund records all physical assets such as buildings, equipment and land. In 2019/20 the General Plant Fund was increased \$2,131. This brings the net assets of the General Plant Fund at the end of the year 2019/20 to \$177,865.

General Fund Restricted Accounts

- Bequest Fund receives undesignated estate gifts of \$500 or more. In 2019, \$80,419 was transferred to the annual budget. \$35,320.76 was earned in interest and market adjustments on the Bequest Fund account.
- Koontz Memorial Fund for the continuing education needs of WDC pastors earned \$2,032.37 in interest and market adjustments. The fund made 15 grants totaling \$2,380.
- Doris Goertz Scholarship Fund for individuals with particular needs who are preparing for or serving in a Christian vocation earned \$380.23 in interest. Three grants were awarded totaling \$750.
- Congregational Development Fund defrays the cost of consultation related to congregational and ministerial discernment processes. This fund earned \$4,036.19 in interest and market adjustments. The fund also received \$2,253.86 in repayments. The fund made 8 grants to congregations totaling \$6,063.63.
- The Annuity Gift Program began and ended the year with two participants.
- Western District Women in Mission Scholarship Fund provides seminary scholarships for women from the Western District. In 2019/20 this fund earned \$1,031.68 in interest which partially funded scholarships for WDC women attending seminary.
- Other restricted accounts result from retreats, workshops, scholarship funds and grants. Commissions that govern the various accounts detail the activities of these accounts in reports.
