# Annual Financial Report for Western District Conference – July 3, 2024 Shari Scheffler, Business Manager

Certified public accountants of Knudsen, Monroe & Company, LLC, are in the process of auditing all financial records and reports of the Western District Conference (WDC) of Mennonite Church USA from fiscal year 2/1/2023-1/31/2024 in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. WDC will make this report available to members upon request.

WDC records its financial activity with the use of five separate funds:

General Fund (Fund 1). This fund records the transactions of the principal budgeted ministries of WDC. It is into this fund that individual, organizational and congregational contributions go to pay for conference expenses. In the fiscal year ended January 31, 2024, the General Fund had \$532,746.58 of total income. Of this, \$321,662.41was contributed by member congregations and individuals; \$36,271.48 was income from interest, honorariums and reimbursements; and the remaining \$174,812.69 was pulled from designated funds within the Restricted Fund (Fund 4). Of the designated funds used, \$118,378.85 came from the Bequest Fund, which was 17.5% of its year-end balance. It is standard policy that 10% of the Bequest Fund is automatically moved into the General Fund at the end of the fiscal year; but, up to 20% can be transferred to cover General Fund expenses with approval of the Executive Board. Initially the 17.5% of the Bequest Fund was thought to balance out the expenses for the year; however, after some further accounting transactions to close out the 2500 Place Fund and redistribute some of the expenses related to insurance, the General Fund was left with a net deficit of \$5,733.00 for the fiscal year; but, had total assets of \$97,744.07 and \$7,991.34 in liabilities owed.

**2500 Place Fund (Fund 2)**. This fund was closed at the end of the fiscal year ending January 31, 2024. It operated separately from the General Fund and included all transactions related to the office and retail building known as "2500 Place" owned by the conference in North Newton, KS. As noted in last year's financial report for Assembly, WDC sold the building in July of 2023. WDC now leases a reduced square footage of our previous space from G5 Investments, LLC. The sales proceeds from the building were used to pay off 2500 Place liabilities and expenses, with the remaining \$420,844.38 being moved into a designated fund held at Everence Trust Company (now part of Restricted Fund - Fund 4).

**Revolving Fund (Fund 3)**. This fund operates separately, is governed by the Trustees Task Force under the Stewardship Commission, and is used to loan money -- primarily to finance church buildings for member congregations and for capital improvements on conference property. In the fiscal year ending January 31, 2024, the Revolving Fund collected a total of \$9,987.06 of interest income on four loans. At year end, total assets of the Revolving Fund were \$556,431.25, and only \$27,561.15 of that was money owed from outstanding loans.

Restricted Fund (Fund 4). This fund is comprised of monies designated for specific purposes, sometimes referred to as the General Fund Restricted Accounts. It contains both WDC-designated and donor-designated funds. These accounts are used to record grants and other restricted monies received or designated, and track transactions from these funds. These funds are each assigned to either the Executive Board or one of the Commissions for oversight. The overseeing body has the ability to determine the use of the funds in accordance with restrictions set forth by the donor(s), or at their discretion in regards to WDC-designated funds. At the end of the fiscal year, the Restricted Fund had total assets of \$1,872,851.36.

**General Plant Fund (Fund 5).** This fund records the value of all physical assets (such as buildings, equipment and land) less accumulated depreciation. These numbers are calculated with the assistance of the Certified Public Accountants during the annual financial audit.
