• Carried out the policy requiring all ministers to take Healthy Boundaries training.

# Resourcing ministry teams that include pastors and deacons through workshops, retreats, and other appropriate events.

- MLC co-sponsored with Everence an English language Pastors' Retreat at Crosswind Retreat Center, Hesston, KS, on April 16-17. Resource persons: Sara Dick and Chywonna Gonzalez. Music/Worship leaders: Doug and Jude Krehbiel. A Spanish language retreat is being planned for Sept. 27-28 at Lakeview Retreat Camp/Retreat Center, Waxahachie, TX, with resource person Luis Tapia from AMBS.
- Two females have been appointed to an Abuse Prevention and Response Resource Team that can be available to congregations and to the MLC. An additional male is still being sought.
- MLC is planning a "come and go" reception for pastors at the Annual Assembly of WDC.
- MLC continues to work on developing a series of resourcing topics to be offered for pastors and congregational leaders.
- MLC meets monthly to tend to the larger picture of ministerial leadership in WDC and support the conference ministers in their work.

The MLC affirmed that they recognize ministerial credentials granted by South Central Conference while they were fellow members of MCUSA, and will accept transfers of ministers in good standing with South Central. We will offer them the normal orientation for new ministers in WDC. We will ask ministers to fill out the annual accountability plan upon receiving their credentials. Our preference would be for all the ministers to have a Ministerial Leadership Information form, but do not mandate it. MLIs of incoming transfers will be made available to the MLC. The MLC continues to consider our role in repentance and transformation as called for by the MCUSA resolution approved at the Special Assembly in 2022 in Kansas City. We acknowledge that the MLC played a role in excluding LGBTQ persons from ministry in the past. We are reaching out to apologize to pastors who we know were denied pastoral positions in WDC because of their sexual orientation.
