For years, we've relied on occasional large capital campaigns to partially fund the mission of the Western District Conference. Now, as we enter a new season of planning for our future, we sense a call to move in a different direction. As a Mennonite community rooted in simplicity, shared responsibility, and mutual aid, we're shifting toward something more sustainable—something more us. We are moving towards a member-owned model, asking each member of WDC congregations to consider making a modest, yet regular financial commitment to WDC, either through your congregation or directly to WDC. This vision has three dimensions:



Rooted Giving - The work of WDC is rooted in the priorities, values, community, and investments of each of our members.



Seeds of Sustenance - With small, yet sustaining investments, we each "plant seeds" to ensure a healthy future for our conference and congregations.



Together We Tend - To thrive, it takes all of us tending to the future of our conference. We grow together!

When each of us invests faithfully, we build a conference that's not dependent on occasional bursts of generosity by some, but instead, is grounded in a regular rhythm of care by many.

- Transitional ministers and hands-on support for churches navigating pastoral transitions.
- Resource Library the oldest and largest Mennonite church resource center in the United States, with an expanding selection of digital resources.

- Coaching for leaders of emerging faith communities and scholarships for seminary students.
- Consulting with churches for pastorcongregation reviews, updating policies, safe-church training, and more.
