

International Women's Fund --- annual scholarships



The IWF scholarship fund helps women around the world receive training for church leadership and makes a way for supporting women scholars by preserving 100% of designated donations for awards. In 2026 we are renewing scholarships for 30 women and welcoming 14 new scholars—a total of 44 women across 15 countries, receiving \$14,400 for their studies in theology, pastoral leadership, conflict transformation, peace studies, Christian education, counseling, and other forms of ministry leadership.
